Working with young people age 8-19 (25 with additional needs), we transform lives, helping them be the best they can be.



Whilst sitting within the Communications Team, you will be a vital asset across the board, from comms to fundraising to delivery.

## **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Use Salesforce to input and export data for reporting on projects and programmes and the overall impact of the Youth Zone
- Work closely with the Head of Marketing and Communications, Head of Operations and our Grants & Trusts Coordinator, to ensure up to date, relevant and correct statistics and figures
- Keep the delivery team updated on measurables of all projects, ensuring they are achieving and exceeding KPI's

- Ensure regular reviews and evaluation of projects, capturing outcomes and impact
- Be embedded in our values and gain an understanding of our full offer. Use this knowledge and data gathered to inform on gaps to young peoples needs and key trends
- Produce monthly management reports, on all projects and programmes
- Comply with all policies and procedures

# THE ESSENTIALS

- Understanding CRM systems with proven experience in using one
- You must be able to demonstrate that you have experience in applying data for reporting and recording
- You will be monitoring multiple projects run by multiple people at any one time so you must be organised, able to prioritise your workload, and ideally, already have experience in monitoring deliverables
- You must be able to work toward short and long-term goals. The team will require regular updates as to whether they are on target for hitting KPIs
- You must be a strategic thinker able to look outside the box.

# THE DESIRABLES
