- Maintain a clean working

 regular cleaning of all work
 surfaces and food areas
- Comply with food hygiene regulations, in particular ensuring food is stored correctly and at correct temperatures; and record all high-risk food temperatures on delivery and prior to service
- Delegate and ensure young leaders are carrying out their role

- Help serve to the public and families during Sundays Family Day
- Ensuring there is enough cold and hot food for all members during session
- Cash handling and the subsequent finance admin
- Keep up to date with all training necessary to your role with the support of the Catering Supervisor
- Ensure all Health and Safety and Environmental Health requirements are adhered to
- Carry out any other reasonable duties as requested by management
- Represent Inspire positively and effectively in all dealings with internal colleagues, and external partners
- Liaise and give feedback to the Catering Supervisor
