THE ROLE

As deputy Youth Work Manager, you will oversee and manage the youth work team, focusing on young people aged 12 to 19 (up to 25 with additional needs).

As the Duty Manager for youth sessions, your responsibilities encompass the overall supervision of the facility, staff, and participating young people. You will lead a diverse team of youth workers to deliver engaging activities. Your role involves guiding, supporting, and developing the Youth Work team to establish and enhance existing programmes for young people, emphasising early intervention and engagement.

Ensuring service excellence, you will manage key performance indicators (KPIs) related to attendance, outcomes, service impact, retention, partnerships, and reputation.

Collaborating with the Youth Work Coordinator, you will manage a caseload of young people referred to the Youth Zone from services supporting vulnerable children and young people. This includes working with Multi-Agency Panels, Children's Social Care, and Schools. Your duties extend to developing a support and intervention programme addressing vulnerabilities and promoting positive and healthy behaviours. You will engage with parents/carers and partner agencies to empower young individuals to make positive choices, fostering safer and more constructive participation in universal provision as they transition to adulthood. This involves assessments, evaluations, and participation in tailored programmes such as 1:1 work, mentoring, small targeted support groups, and nurture groups.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Oversee and execute Duty
 Management, delivering universal and targeted youth services focused on ages 12-19 (up to 25 with SEND) a minimum of three times per week.
- Collaborate with the Youth Work
 Coordinator and wider youth work
 team to provide a vibrant, exciting, and
 inclusive offering to young people,
 fostering a culture of continuous
 improvement.
- Focused on tangible outcomes, leading to improved prospects in health, wellbeing, education, and employment.
- Act as a key holder for the building and Duty Manager, taking responsibility for the safety and well-being of all during duty hours and overseeing the building during sessions (First Aid, Safeguarding, Health and Safety).
- Support the Youth Work Coordinator to implement and enhance an intervention service as part of the EPIC programme, targeting young people facing challenges in engagement.
- Provide direct support to a caseload of young people, actively addressing barriers to positive participation and promoting attendance at senior sessions.
- Work with the communications team to effectively communicate the youth service offer to all young people.
- Align efforts with Inspire's overall strategic plan, focusing on achieving key objectives for the organisation.

- Ensure comprehensive capture, recording, and delivery of all Key Performance Indicators (KPIs), including membership and attendance, project/contract outcomes, budgets, and impact.
- Lead and manage the Youth Work Coordinator and a team of highly skilled Youth Workers, overseeing the delivery of diverse activities, interventions, and support for young people.
- Foster a positive and effective representation of Inspire in all interactions with colleagues, partners, and stakeholders.
- Maintain a consistently positive 'can do' attitude, embodying the organisation's values (Ambitious, Supportive, Present, Inspirational, Committed) at all times.
- Cultivate operational-level networks with key partners, stakeholders, and supporters to establish and nurture relationships that enhance outcomes for young people.
- Act as a positive and engaged member of Inspire's Leadership Team, upholding the highest standards of professionalism and serving as a role model for high performance, continuous improvement, safety, and enjoyment.
