Working with young people age 8-19 (25 with additional needs), we transform lives, helping them be the best they can be.



Together with our partners The Making Rooms – (an organisation dedicated to creative and technical training), you will help develop and deliver a diverse and exciting programme of activities aimed at young people aged 8 to 25 years, that stimulates, develops, and meets the needs of young people from all backgrounds and abilities.

You will utilise creativity and technical problem solving in the wider youth work agenda supporting and encouraging young people to express themselves, develop their technical abilities and facilitate personal development by developing their skills through positive engagement and experiences.
